3. All exhibits to be in hands of stewards at Showgrounds on **Thursday 22nd April between 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm sharp. No exhibit will be accepted unless the entry fee has been paid and entry form is completed.**
4. A new class will be created for any produce not already listed, provided there are two or more entries.
5. All chaff to be not less than 12kg.
6. Trusses of hay to be not less than 12kg.
7. Prize Money halved if only 1 entry received.
8. **Judging time is 10:00 am Friday 23rd April.**
9. **Exhibits to be collected between 4.30 – 5 pm Saturday 24th April.**
