6. This section comes under the Rules & Regulations listed in this Schedule which must be adhered to.
7. Stewards will be at the Showgrounds on Wednesday 21st April between 5:00pm-7:00pm and on Thursday 22nd April between 7am - 11.30am to accept Exhibit Entries.
