Conditions of Entry—Please Read Carefully

4. Any exhibitor under 12 years, mark age on exhibit.
5. Washed exhibits will be disqualified.
6. A special class will be made where possible if 2 or more entries.
7. All exhibits must be in the hands of Stewards between 2pm & 5pm on Wednesday 18 April 2012 - No late entries accepted.
8. **Judging time – 10 am Thursday 19 April 2012.**

Comments from Previous Judges:

Take more attention to framing.

Hankies: Corner Crochet to all match.

Patchwork: No threads on back of work / take more time on mitred corners.

Crochet: Do not stiffen. Do not knot threads. Careful with ironing items & ensure no marks.

Hand towels are Hand Towels, and Tea Towels are Fridge Towels.

Dolls: Use doll shoes or hand paint shoes.
