CONDITIONS – COMPETITORS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. All cattle to be yarded by 3.00pm Thursday 22nd April.
2. Cattle not to be returned before 2.00pm Saturday 24th April.
3. **Judging to commence 7.00am Friday 23rd April.**
4. Trophies and sashes presented 12.00noon Friday 23rd April.
5. Auction Sale commences 1.00pm Friday 23rd April.
6. Cattle will be judged for early maturity, breeding, quality, confirmation, evenness and depth of flesh. Vealers and Yearlings may be of any breed or sex. Any cross breeds are eligible to compete. All horned cattle must be tipped. Cattle entered in Pen Classes cannot be entered for, nor compete in, classes for single exhibits.
7. **All Cattle must be EAR TAGGED with a NUMBERED PRIME CATTLE tag prior to show.** Assistance is available. Contact Chief Steward. Tags are available from Kilcoy Rural donated by **ALLFLEX**
8. **All cattle must be mouthed prior to show date.** Assistance available, contact the Chief Steward.
9. Third prize money paid only when five (5) or more entries judged in that class.
10. Age tags to be placed on all exhibits except full mouth cattle. Milktooth Orange, 2 Tooth White, 4 Tooth Blue, 6 Tooth Yellow. All cattle without age tags will be deemed to be full mouth. Tags are available from Kilcoy Rural free of charge.
11. Random checking will take place at the discretion of the judge or stewards.
12. All cattle not sold will be liable for commission at 5%.
13. Entry fee \$3.00 per entry. Entry forms must be lodged with Kilcoy Rural prior to show day.
14. **ENTRY FEES Will be deducted from sale proceeds. DO NOT PAY with nominations.**
15. All cattle must be bonafide property of the exhibitor for a period of at least 3 months prior to the show date.
16. All cattle with access to grain **must** be exhibited in grain fed classes.
17. **NLIS scanning \$1.65 per head.**

18. **All cattle will be weighed full on arrival at Show Grounds (Schedule Weights will apply).**
19. **PLEASE NOTE – if registered for GST, you will be required to supply your own completed Tax Invoices for Prize Monies over \$50.00.**
